Gwen Verdon - was an actress and dancer who won four Tony awards for her musical comedy.

BeBe Nuewirth - is an American actress, musician and dancer. She has worked in television and is known for her portrayal of Dr. Lilith Sternin, Dr. Frasier Crane's wife (later ex-wife), on both the TV sitcom *Cheers* and *Frasier*.

Bob Fosse - was an American actor, dancer, musical theater choreographer, director, screenwriter, film editor and film director. He won an unprecedented eight Tony Awards for choreography, as well as one for direction.

Jerry Herman - is an American composer and lyricist, known for his work in Broadway musical theater. He composed the scores for the hit Broadway musicals *Hello, Dolly!*, *Mame*, and *La Cage aux Folles*.

Lorelei - *Lorelei* is a musical theatre revision of the Joseph Fields-Anita Loos book for the 1949 production *Gentlemen Prefer Blondes*.

Bajour, The Rink - Lesser known Broadway shows.

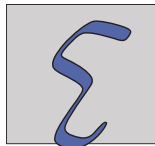

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Mandy Patinkin - is an award-winning American actor of stage and screen and a tenor vocalist.

Chanteuse - SONGSTRESS; *especially*: a woman who is a concert or nightclub singer.

Puccini - was an Italian composer whose operas, including *La bohème*, *Tosca*, *Madama Butterfly*, and *Turandot*, are among the most frequently performed in the standard repertoire.

Anthony Rapp (Mark) - is an American stage and film actor and singer best known for originating the role of Mark Cohen in the Broadway production of *Rent* in 1996.

Adam Pascal (Roger) - is an American actor and singer known for his performance as Roger Davis in the original cast of Jonathan Larson's musical *Rent* on Broadway 1996.

Daphne Rubin Vega - is a dancer, singer, and actress. She is best known for originating the role of Mimi Marquez in the Broadway musical *Rent*, Mike Nichols-is a German-born American television, stage and film director, writer, producer and comedian.

Eric Idle - is an English comedian, actor, author, singer, writer, and comedic composer. He was a member of the British surreal comedy group Monty Python, a member of the The Rutles on *Saturday Night Live*, and the author of the Broadway musical *Spamalot*.

Torch Song Trilogy - is a collection of three plays by Harvey Fierstein rendered in three acts: *International Stud*, *Fugue in a Nursery*, and *Widows and Children First!* The story centers on Arnold Beckoff, a torch song-singing Jewish drag queen living in New York City in the late 1970 and 1980s. The four hour-plus play begins with a soliloquy in which he explains his cynical disillusionment with love.

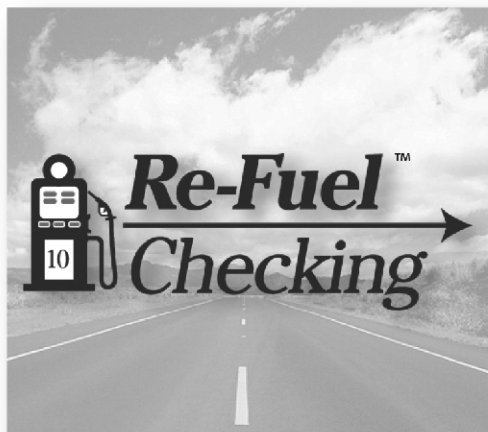
