

NEIL SIMON. PLAYWRIGHT

Neil Simon is considered by many to be the world's most successful playwright. He has had dozens of plays and nearly as many major motion pictures produced.

He has been showered with more Academy and Tony nominations than any other writer, and is the only playwright to have four Broadway productions running simultaneously. His plays have been produced in dozens of languages, and have been blockbuster hits from Beijing to Moscow. His true success, however, is in his unique way of exposing something real in the American spirit.



Rumors, Simon's twenty-fourth Broadway production, opened on November 17, 1988 at the Broadhurst Theatre, where it ran for slightly more than a year before transferring to the Ethel Barrymore, for a total run of 535 performances. Christine Baranski won the Tony Award for Best Performance by a Featured Actress in a Play for her portrayal of Chris Gorman.


